

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International students recommended by quality exchange programs with equal qualifications as determined by the school administration may attend Bondurant-Farrar High School under the following conditions:

1. Requesting agencies must submit a student application and resume to the high school principal or counselor prior to the academic year of proposed attendance.
2. The student must reside within the boundaries of this district with an approved host family.
3. The applicant usually must be at least sixteen (16) years old by September 1st of the enrollment year.
4. Exchange students will pay normal expenses, such as lunch tickets and activity tickets.

Only one (1) foreign exchange student each school year [the first one approved by the board] will receive the following:

The school district will waive book and lab fees.

The application procedures will be determined by the high school principal. Selection will be by the host family with approval from the high school principal.
