

INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE STUDENTS

International exchange students must meet all district entrance requirements including age, place of residence and immunization. International exchange students must be approved by the board. The board reserves the right to limit the number of international exchange students accepted. Students who are citizens of a foreign country will be considered residents if they meet one of the following requirements:

- The student resides with his/her parents(s) or legal guardian;
- The student is in the United States with appropriate documentation (Form I-20) from the United States Department of Justice-Immigration and Naturalization Services; or
- The student is a participant in a recognized international exchange program; and,
- The student is physically able to attend school and has provided the school district with such proof, including a current TB test.
