The meeting was called to order at 6:32 p.m. by Laurel Swanson, president.

Minutes from April – Members reviewed copies of the August board meeting. Kristin Swift made a motion to approve the minutes; Courtney Morris seconded. Motion passed.

Financial Reports and Updates – Swift presented the financial report. Accounts have been cleaned up to reflect adjusting general and miscellaneous line items and similar with band. Fine Arts accounts between checking and savings have approximately \$2200. Most of the money resides in the Foundation accounts. In the savings – Viewers Choice and Musical have been split to separate line items per August discussion. Karen Keeran moved to approve the financial report. Holly Wingert seconded.

Art – Mr. Vandelaar will have the art t-shirt design finalized and ready to go live for sale this week and next. He’s hoping there will be enough sales to pay for the scholastics and all-state entries.

Band – Holly Wingert reported two remaining home game performances with a family showcase held Saturday, October 3 at 7:30 p.m. Guidelines for attendance will be similar to football games, with a slideshow on the scoreboard and student recognition. Concert Band is working with two separate bands as A day and B day and currently unsure of performances. Mr. Wipperman is looking to provide some video performances but working through copyright concerns. He is also looking for find a cost-effective solution for uniform cleaning.

Choir – Mr. Hucke reported he’s looking into video-produced concerts. He’s working with a combination of public domain and a copyright version that has an agreement with Facebook usage and continuing to work out the video plan with a goal to post mid- to late-October. All state prep is ongoing with seven students considering auditioning, all online, video. The audition cuts will be released a month early. Current plan for all-state is three concerts spread out time-wise at Hilton.

Drama – Working on play prep. Performance information can be provided on social media when it is finalized. Note: Post-meeting email agrees to pay for cost of platform materials and potential costume needs.
