

Fine Arts Boosters Minutes
October 21, 2019

The meeting was called to order in the high school media center at 6:30 by Rachele Lorentzen.

Minutes from September – Members reviewed copies of the September board meeting. McCleary made a motion to approve the minutes, Aanonson second. Motion passed.

Financial Reports and Updates – The treasurer, Rachele Lorentzen, presented the financial reports. There is currently \$18,252.94 in the FAB accounts and \$31,155.40 in the Foundation accounts. Davidson made a motion to approve the minutes, Aanonson second. Motion passed.

Reports from FAB Representatives/FA Teachers

Art – Darla Davidson reported for Mr. Vandehaar. The mural is done. This will be installed on the bus barn facing the trail. It looks GREAT! He anticipates the art shirts should be coming this week and will be handed out next week. The total profit was \$560. This will come close to paying for the 40 individual submissions for scholastics (\$200) and most of the portfolios for both scholastics (~\$100?) and All-State (\$200-300 depending on what gets done). Scholastics will be needed to be submitted by Thanksgiving break.

Band – Braden Wipperman reported that the band is finished with marching competitions and they are starting to work on concert band. He has one student planning to try out for All-State percussion this Saturday. Jazz band will start after soon.

Choir – Coren Hucke reported that he has taken two small groups of students to Central and Wartburg Colleges. The Fall Concert will be Tuesday, October 22. He has 10 students auditioning for All-State this Saturday and 10 students auditioning for ISU Honor Choir soon. Bondurant is hosting the Raccoon River Conference Honor Choir Tuesday, October 29. There will be ~15 BF students and ~120 total. They will start ~9:30 or 10. The students will eat the BF school lunch. They will have Jimmy Johns box lunch for dinner ~4:30 with the cost covered by the conference. The concert will be ~6 pm with a \$6 admission fee that goes to the conference. Volunteers were obtained at the September meeting with Denise Fick, Lorentzen and Laurel Swanson to serve dinner. Morris and Davidson will distribute programs.

Drama – Participants will have a pizza party on Thursday, November 7. The play will be on Friday, November 8 and Saturday, November 9 at 7 pm. They will do seats like last year. School employees will do the ticket sales. Locker signs are done. Doors will open at 6:30. Volunteers will be there at 6:25. The volunteers will be at the doors and also help out with intermission treats. Students will bring in 2 dozen desserts each and these will be provided at intermission for a free-will offering. Friday volunteers: Aanonson and Kristin Swift or Lorentzen; Saturday: McCleary and Morris.
